## MEETING MINUTES OF April 4, 2018

The regular meeting of the Gladwin County Board of Road Commissioners was held on Wednesday, April 4, 2018 at 9:30 a.m.

Payment voucher 18-07 was presented for approval for payroll in the amount of \$57,232.24 & 22,447.27 and bills payable in the amount of \$110,630.59. Motion was made by Commissioner Brabon and seconded by Commissioner Cameron. Motion carried.

Karon Hoffman, Clement Township Supervisor thanked us doing a nice job on Rutledge Road.

Larry Grell, Billings Township Supervisor, discussed some drainage issues in the township.

Cash balances were provided.

The plans for the new building are moving along as expected.

Motion was made by Commissioner Brabon and seconded by Commissioner Cameron to adopt the following resolution:

The Gladwin County Road and Bridge Millage Ballot Wording for the August 7, 2018 Primary Election and November 2018 Election if necessary was presented and attached to these minutes, revised from the attached ballot in the March 21, 2018 minutes.
