

GLADWIN COUNTY BOARD OF ROAD COMMISSIONERS

MEETING MINUTES OF

MARCH 25, 2015

The regular meeting of the Gladwin County Board of Road Commissioners was held on Wednesday, March 25, 2015 at 9:30 A.M. Meeting was called to order by the Vice Chairman, Doyle Donn. Present were Commissioners Donn and Brabon, also Dave Pettersch, Manager and Dayna L. Bittner, Clerk-Secretary. Commissioner Edick was absent. A list of others attending the meeting is attached to these minutes at the road commission office.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes from the March 11, 2015 regular meeting were presented for approval. Motion was made by Commissioner Brabon to approve the minutes as presented. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Donn and carried.

Payment vouchers 15-07 and 15-08 were presented for approval of payroll in the amount of \$54,526.55 and bills payable in the amount of \$93,612.12. Motion was made by Commissioner Brabon and seconded by Commissioner Donn to approve the payment vouchers. Motion carried.

Karon Hoffman, Clement Township Supervisor, expressed gratitude for fixing the water over Mohawk Trail.

Ann McClain, Buckeye Township resident, made some ditching requests.

Larry Grell, Billings Township Supervisor, requested boom arm work and ditching.

Arden Shell, Gladwin Township resident, asked about safety at the intersection of Bard Rd. and Eaton Rd. He presented a letter from Mary Price, a local bus driver expressing her concerns with the intersection. It was read out loud by Commissioner Brabon. Arden Shell also asked about the pit run that was applied to Youngs Road. Dave Pettersch explained that it was rutted and underwater and the pit run was used to build it up.

Discussion took place in regards to Proposal 1.

Jack Kleinhardt, Traffic Crash Investigator for Clare County Road Commission can attend the next board meeting to discuss the services he offers.

Discussion took place in regards to ditch enclosure permits and the requirement to provide a drawing as well as a schedule of inspections.
